2015-2016 Jerry Bailey Educational Opportunity Scholarship

Application Instructions

The Jerry Bailey Educational Opportunity Scholarship was established to provide financial support for low-income, underrepresented, and first-generation students as they pursue an undergraduate degree at the University of Kansas. Current or former participants in a KU Center for Educational Opportunity Program (CEOP) receive preference, but participation is not required. One to two scholarships will be awarded ranging from \$750 - \$1,500.

ELIGIBILITY / SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicant must be an entering freshman/transfer student OR continuing undergraduate student, enrolled full-time (12+hours) at KU during the Fall 2015 term. The Selection Committee will give preference to applicants who meet as many as possible of the following criteria:

- Demonstrate financial need
- Have first-generation college-going status, meaning neither parent/guardian has earned a 4-year college degree
- Are current or former participants of a KU CEOP program
- Have achieved academic success despite hardship or unusual challenge
- Demonstrate personal motivation for achieving academic and career goals

Typed, double-spaced, and not to exceed 2 pages, answering BOTH of the following: 1) Choose an experience from your life and explain how it has influenced your educational goals, AND 2) Describe any personal experiences or exceptional hurdles which impact your need for financial assistance.
